



Dear Friend:

In the U.S., more children die of childhood cancer than any other disease — more than AIDS, asthma, cystic fibrosis, congenital anomalies, and diabetes combined. And yet, all types of childhood cancers combined receive only 4% of the U.S. federal funding for cancer research. Our community has felt the direct impact of childhood cancer. We have lost several local children in recent years to this dreaded disease; not to mention the countless local kids currently in the battle for their lives.

The need is so great, we were inspired to help.

To that end, we started Compete for a Cause. It began with just one high school soccer game in 2012 and had grown exponentially each and every year. At our 2019 event, attendance exceeded 2,000 people and we raised over \$38,000! Cumulatively, we've raised over \$250,000 of which \$90,000 has been donated to St. Baldrick's (the largest provider of grants to fund childhood cancer research). The remaining balance of the funds has supported the MSU Pediatric Oncology Clinic as well as direct assistance to local families whose children are being treated at the MSU Clinic, C.S. Mott Children's Hospital, and the Helen DeVos Children's Hospital.

Then came COVID.

In 2019, we made a direct donation of \$20,000 to the St. Baldrick's Foundation, were able to purchase \$11,945 of materials and equipment for the MSU Pediatric Clinic, and gave \$9,080 as direct payments to families. In total, \$40,121.65 was donated in 2019 to help the collective fight against childhood cancer. Our 2020 help was \$7,461, our 2021 \$3,911, and our 2022 help was only \$5,549.

This is a trend we want to CHANGE!

While COVID and time restrictions did not allow us to have events these past few years, we are bringing back personalized game jerseys, Compete for a Cause t-shirts, game-day activities, and new awareness events to the 2023 Mason vs. Okemos girls' soccer game on May 5th.
